



provide space rent-free when available, two Council board members met with Christine Ray, Chief of Staff to Deputy PMG Stroman. The USPS Facilities team was consulted on the lease situation and we have been told it is resolved. According to Ray, "The space is free as long as it is a postal credit union and available to postal employees and does not have to be limited to postal employees." Further, they advised that if any specific active postal credit union is receiving information about paying for a lease or that they will need to move, please contact the Council with the specifics of your credit union's situation so that it can be directed to the appropriate individual at USPS headquarters.

"Despite this being peak season for the Postal Service, we appreciate that they made the resolution of this issue a priority," commented NCPCU Chairman Kevin Yaeger. "We appreciate the long-standing relationship between our two organizations and look forward to continuing to serve our members in the coming year."
