

Recent Memo Aims to Reverse USPS's Position on Employee Access

Just weeks before NCPCU's 33rd Annual Conference in Las Vegas last month, a memo was distributed to all area managers citing that the Postal Service is prohibiting "business or charitable solicitation and commercial vending on all real property under the charge and control of the Postal Service." A handful of credit unions have reported receiving the memo and have been told they can no longer attend employee orientations. The memo lists examples of activities that are prohibited under a broad interpretation of two federal regulations.

The Council maintains its position that these regulations do not apply to postal credit unions based on the 100-year partnership with the Postal Service and is actively looking into the legal foundation underlying this recent interpretation. NCPCU has also approached other credit union organizations with similar relationships to the military and government sectors. Watch for updates as more develops on this vital issue to postal credit unions.
