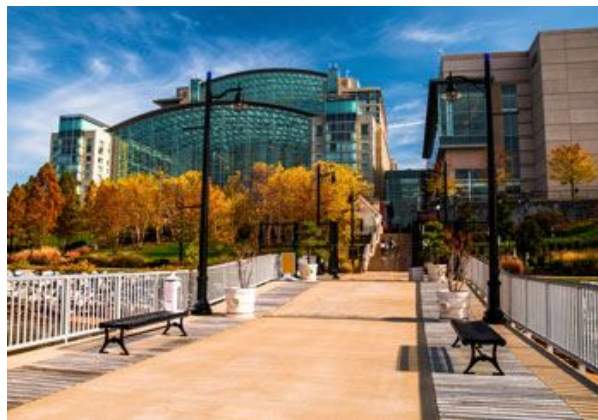
Eagle-Image Plastic EMV Cards Available
