## Three Postal Credit Unions Involved in Mergers

Minnesota's third largest credit union, TruStone Financial Federal Credit Union, will acquire Kenosha Postal Employees Credit Union effective September 10. In January, TruStone acquired two other area credit unions, raising its assets to nearly \$1.1 billion. It's not clear if the credit union will continue to operate a branch out of the Kenosha Post Office following the merger.

In April, Postmark Credit Union in Pennsylvania announced it will merge on September 1 with Xceed Financial Credit Union headquartered in California.

San Gabriel Valley Postal Credit Union merged into CU SoCal (Credit Union of Southern California), formerly a schools-based credit union that opened membership to three of the largest counties in the Los Angeles area.
