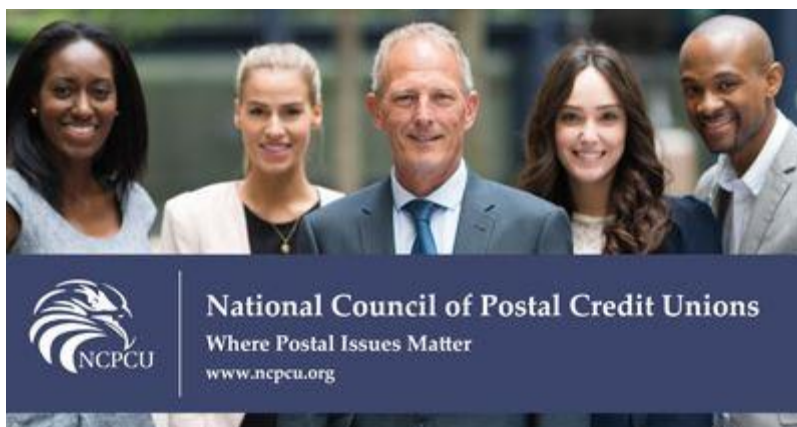

NCPCU's Nominating Committee is now accepting nominations for the 2017 Board elections. Three board members' terms, including Sidney Parfait, Vladimir Stark, and Kevin Yaeger, are expiring at NCPCU's Annual Business Meeting on May 2, 2017 in National Harbor, Maryland. Anyone interested in running for the nine-person board should submit their nominations no later than Friday, March 31, 2017. As outlined in NCPCU's Bylaws three basic candidate requirements include:

1. Must be either an operating officer or a volunteer holding elective office in a member credit union.
2. Credit union must have been a member of the Council for at least one year.
3. Individual must have participated in at least one NCPCU Annual Conference.
